The Fryske Akademy organizes the first Conference on Frisian Humanities, in the Municipal Theatre De Harmonie in Leeuwarden, on 23 to 26 April 2018, as part of the project *Lân fan taal* (Land of language) of Leeuwarden-Fryslân European Capital of Culture 2018.

On Wednesday 25 and Thursday 26 April, the focus of the conference will be on multilingualism. The purpose is to bring together practitioners, policy-makers and researchers of multilingualism. This part is organised jointly by the Mercator Research Centre and Afûk (Frisian language promotion). We invite papers in all fields of multilingualism to stimulate discussion and novel ideas in the field of multilingualism. We are particularly interested in papers covering new trends on multilingualism research such as:

- Long-term effects of fostering multilingualism
- Language promotion
- Multilingual practices in social media
- Encounters between different languages (e.g. minority, migrant and foreign languages)
- Approaches for teaching multiple languages.

The papers will be organised in thematic parallel sessions.
